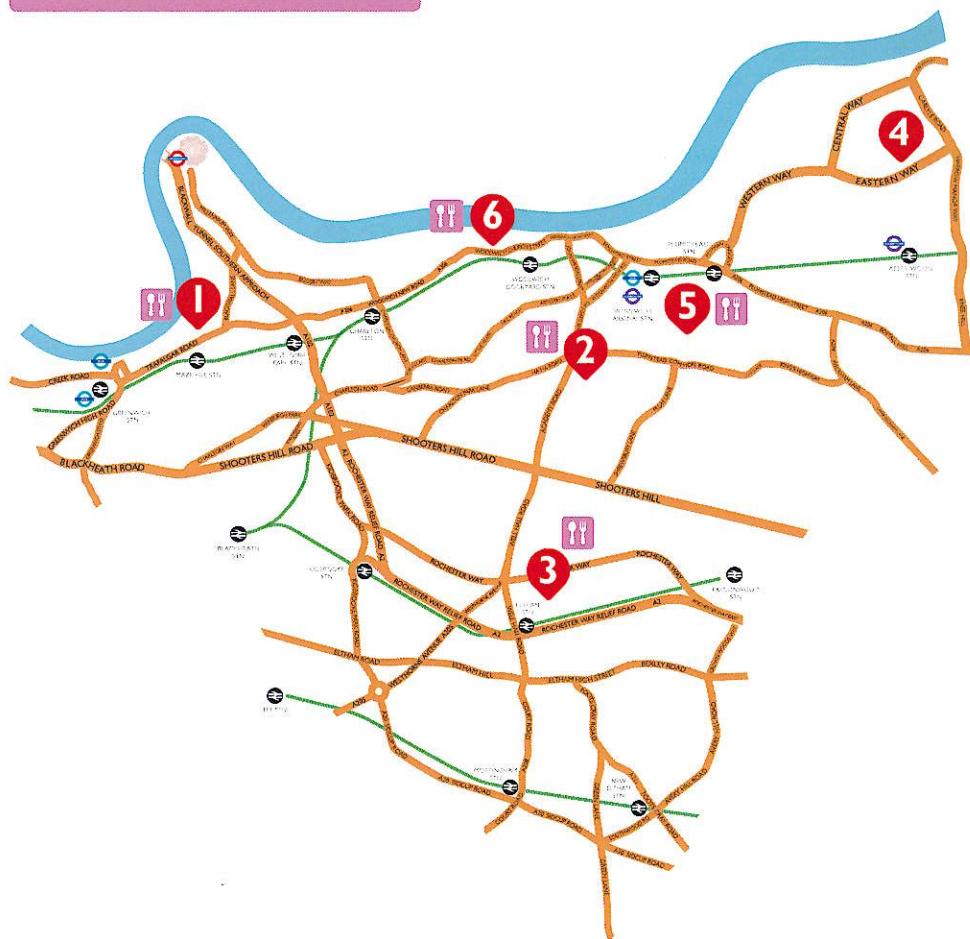

Get the right support, when and where you need it. Whether you need help with your finances, your immigration status, or want to know what benefits you are entitled to – we will be on hand to help you.

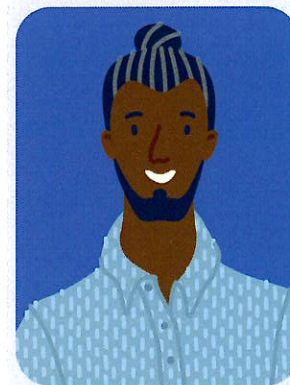

Our Advice Hubs can get very busy. We try to help as many residents as we can, but spaces are limited. If we're full, our team will direct you to another session or team that can help you. To give yourself the best chance of being seen, please come early.

FREE ADVICE AND SUPPORT FOR FAMILIES

Do you have children? If the answer is yes, then you can get free independent advice on benefits, housing, childcare, immigration, disability support and employment.

You can access this support if your child is under 19, or up to 25 if your child has special educational needs or disabilities (SEND).

What can you get help with?

- Checking your benefit entitlement to help maximise your income
- Accessing emergency support if you are struggling to afford essentials
- Advice on childcare costs and reducing financial hardship
- Foodbank vouchers and support with utility arrears
- Specialist housing advice and support

How can you access support?

You can visit one of our drop-in sessions at local Children's Centres and Family Hubs for advice and support.
